Their aim is to determine the most appropriate avenue to meet an array of family goals and bring a memorable sporting experience to these children. Operation Teammate has teamed up with former NFL player Marques Ogden, to spread our message and create that memorable sporting experience.

How does Operation Teammate reach our goals?

There are over 2 million U.S. Military and First Responder families across the nation; 20% of those parents are away from home on duty throughout each calendar year.

There is no alternative community outlet that match children of U.S. Military and First Responder parents with sporting organizations (high school/college/professional), with intent of providing supporting interaction during times of separation. Operation Teammate is also unique in the fact that each of our board members has been a family member of active duty military while experiencing that time of separation and have rallied together during multiple deployments.

Sporting experiences are socially universal and have always provided the opportunity for children/parents to take a time out and relax from everyday life. The opportunities that Operation Teammate offers tremendously enhance that objective and provides a unique & memorable sporting experience for those children that have a parent away from home.

Operation Teammate participants not only relate to other military/first responder children, but have a warm place in their hearts for our nation's heroes because they too have experienced extreme family circumstances during family separations.

Areas of Impact:

The Operation Teammate primary focus area is the southeast United States; to date, events have been conducted in South Carolina and North Carolina. Additionally, Operation Teammate is in coordination with various families/teams across Georgia, Tennessee and Florida to schedule events during the summer of 2016 and into the proceeding seasons. Our most recent event was with the Columbia Fireflies minor league baseball team, in South Carolina. Activities during this event included showing an Operation Teammate promotional video, an Operation Teammate member throwing out the first pitch, and an opportunity to fellowship with fans about our organization.
